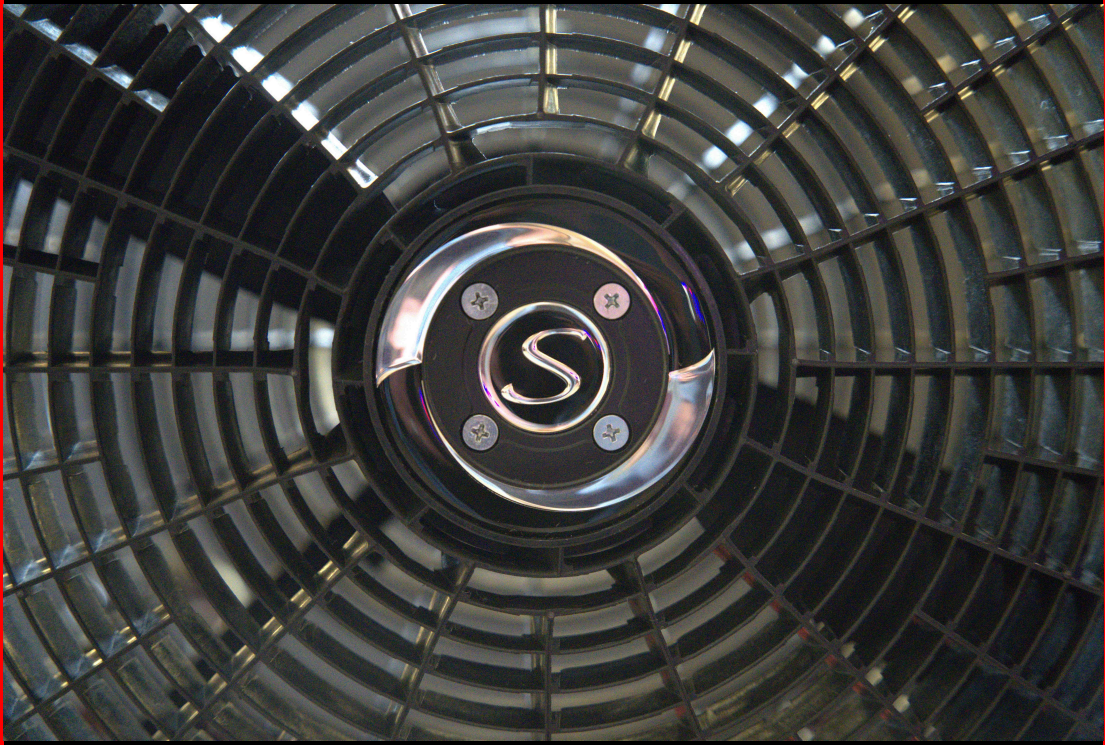

## Education Station:

It's not a Cone, it's not a Straight Jet, it's High-Flow Jet:

High-Flow Jet Technology is a revolutionary type of airstream developed by BlowHard.

In 2018 we launched High-Flow Jet in the Quickee and Commando.

This technology increases airstream entrainment resulting in high expansion and increased CFM to seal the door yet sustain power, momentum, and directional flow to maximize ventilation and pressurization.

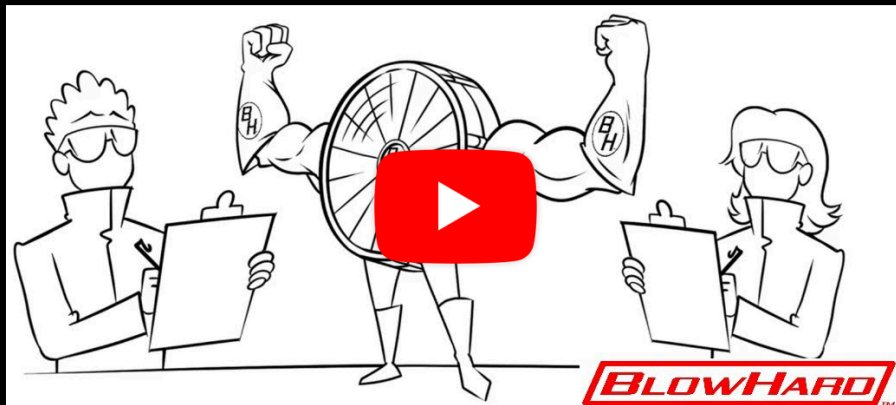
But why stop there?

In 2024 with the launch our X-Series line of fans, starting with the Squirt, we honed High-Flow Jet to entrain air at an even more aggressive rate, improving performance yet again!

This is a key reason the Squirt weighing in at only 38lbs with a small 17" blade outperforms it's predecessor, the Quickee, and all other battery-operated PV fans on the market except our own larger fans!

## Did You Know?

When BlowHard designed the first folding PPV fan, it wasn't just to conserve space on the truck but also for weight distribution and ergonomics when carrying.



Most of the weight is in the base of the fan, held closest to the body to be more settled and balanced with less swinging and pulling.

From the BH-20 to the Quickee to the Squirt, we've improved the design with each model!
